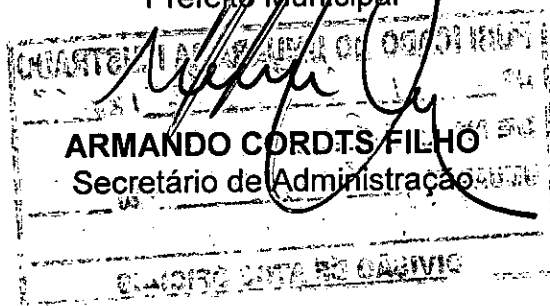
RESOLVE:
